Outstanding things in town:

Lights in town – permit for LED update is being reviewed by the solicitor; when completed we can move ahead with the new LED lights.

Potteiger Park lighting will be completed in 2019; parking lot paving will go out for bids. The top of Rich & Nancy's bench had to be replaced because the powder coating was separating from the metal. The company did fix it. The fire company's bench is also doing it. ½ of the tree that was planted in memory of Marlene has died and someone has cut it off. There will be a tree planted in memory of Mrs. Adams planted by Rich & Nancy's bench.

Signs for Carlisle Pike – ordered and should be in in a few weeks – the large sign was approved by PennDOT and has been ordered. NKV will pay for the sign and present the check to the township.
