

RESOLUTION 2013-18

WHEREAS, the municipality of Silver Spring, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, desires to encourage our state legislators, Honorable Senator Vance and Honorable Representative Grell and

WHEREAS, the state's roads and bridges have been underfunded for more than a decade, which has led to less investment in our local roads and led to higher costs to motorists for heavy wear and tear on their vehicles; and

WHEREAS, Pennsylvania needs a long-term, comprehensive, multi-modal transportation funding investment. **Senate Bill 1** (PN 1162), as passed by the Senate in June, provides for a significant investment in state and local roads and bridges, mass transit, and multi-modal transit systems. New revenue would largely come from increases in user fees (licensing, registration and permitting fees) and the uncapping of the Oil Company Franchise Tax.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the municipality of Silver Spring, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, heartily recommends your positive support for the various bills enumerated in this resolution.

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Secretary is directed to transmit this resolution to Senator Vance and Representative Grell and the Pennsylvania State Association of Township Supervisors/Commissioners
