RESOLUTION 2013-04

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE RATES OF COMPENSATION
OF THE SILVER SPRING TOWNSHIP TAX COLLECTOR

WHEREAS, Silver Spring Township is a Township of the Second Class in the County of Cumberland, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the Board of Supervisors of Silver Spring Township to establish the compensation of the Tax Collector.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of Silver Spring Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania as follows:

The commission or compensation of the Township Tax Collector for the year 2014 and annually thereafter for the collection of Township real property taxes is hereby fixed at one and three quarters per cent (1.75%) of collections actually received up to \$700,000.00; three quarters of one percent (.75%) of collections actually received from \$700,001.00 up to \$1,500,000.00; and one half of one percent (.50%) for collections actually received over \$1,500,000.00, whether such taxes are paid during the discount period, the flat rate period, or the penalty period.

In the event that the Township Tax Collector collects the Township Per Capita Tax, the Tax Collector shall be paid \$1.00 per bill for Per Capita collections paid in full.
