**RESOLUTION 2016-05**

**A RESOLUTION ALLOWING FOR A CHANGE IN THE  
MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS OF THE  
RECREATION ADVISORY COUNCIL (RAC) AND  
AMENDING RESOLUTION 2014-05**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Silver Spring (the “Township”) has established a Parks and Recreation Department for the Township; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township desires to create an advisory Council to assist the Township in the implementation of the Parks and Recreation Department for the Township.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Silver Spring as follows

**REPEALED - FEB. 24, 2016**

1. The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein by reference.
2. The advisory council shall be known as the Silver Spring Township Recreation Advisory Council (“RAC”).
3. RAC shall consist of seven (7) members, each a Township resident, to be appointed by the Board of Supervisors; with one (1) liaison representing the Board of Supervisors.
4. The members of RAC shall be appointed to five (5) year terms.
5. The members of RAC shall serve without compensation.
6. RAC shall elect a Chairman, Vice-Chairman, and Secretary at its initial meeting each year.
7. RAC shall meet regularly on a schedule satisfactory to the RAC members and the Board of Supervisors.

8. The duties of RAC shall include but not necessarily be limited to the following:
- a. Oversee the implementation of the Comprehensive Recreation & Open Space Plan and the 5-Year Strategic Park & Open Space Plan through periodic reviews, updates, and recommended revisions.
  - b. Annually review fees, rules, policies, and ordinances.
  - c. Support and cooperate with the Township in developing programs for the community.
  - d. Provide recommendation to the Board of Supervisors, relative to parks and recreation.
  - e. Promote cultural diversity projects, which may include, but are not limited to such activities as; brochures, pamphlets, festivals, and other recommendation and reports that will aid the Township and its citizens.
9. Any resolution of parts of resolutions inconsistent with this resolution are hereby repealed.
