

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF  
SILVER SPRING TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

**RESOLUTION 2020-08**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS FOR  
THE VOLUNTEER SERVICE CREDIT PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of Silver Spring Township adopted Ordinance No. 2019-02, the Code of Silver Spring Township (“SST Code”) §§368-49 to 368-55, (“the Volunteer Service Credit Program”) providing tax credits for active volunteer firefighters, fire police officers, emergency medical technicians, and associated administrative members of the Silver Spring Ambulance and Rescue Association, Silver Spring Community Fire Company and the New Kingstown Fire Company (“the Eligible Entities”);

**WHEREAS**, SST Code §368-49 defines “Volunteer” as “[a]n unpaid member of a volunteers fire company or nonprofit emergency medical service agency;

**WHEREAS**, SST Code §368-50 establishes that Volunteers who provide at least sixty (60) hours of service for the Eligible Entities may apply for and shall receive certain tax credits;

**WHEREAS**, SST Code §§368-51 and 368-52 establish the tax credits for municipal earned income tax and real property tax;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to SST Code §368-50, the notarized eligibility lists of all Volunteers who have met the minimum criteria for the Volunteer Service Credit Program have been properly submitted by the Eligible Entities to the Township;

**WHEREAS**, Volunteers that have met the minimum criteria of the Volunteer Service Credit Program for the 2019 Eligibility Period have signed and submitted applications for certification to the chiefs of the Eligible Entity; the chiefs or supervising officers have signed the applications where the Volunteer has met the minimum criteria of the Volunteer Service Credit Program, and they have forwarded the applications to the Township Treasurer.

**WHEREAS**, the Township Treasurer has reviewed the applications for credit under the Volunteer Service Tax Credit Program, has cross-referenced them with the notarized eligibility list, and has forwarded the names of all eligible applicants that are on the notarized eligibility list to the Board of Supervisors by Exhibit ‘A’ attached to this Resolution;

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors, pursuant to SST Code §368-50G, wishes to fulfill its duty to approve all eligible applicants as listed on Exhibit ‘A’ of this Resolution and to direct the Township Treasurer to issue tax credit certificates to the eligible applicants.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of Silver Spring Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The eligible applicants as listed in Exhibit 'A' attached to this Resolution are hereby approved for tax credits under Volunteer Service Credit Program.


**SECTION 2.** The Township Treasurer is directed by the Board of Supervisors to issue tax credit certificates to the approved applicants on Exhibit 'A' of this Resolution.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution is to be effective immediately.
