**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SILVER SPRING  
CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA  
ESTABLISHING MONETARY REIMBURSEMENT FOR  
SNOWPLOW DAMAGED MAILBOXES**

**WHEREAS**, Silver Spring Township Board of Supervisors have determined that a written policy needs to be established regarding mailboxes, mailbox posts and snow plowing; and


**WHEREAS**, that policy shall be:

- 1) If a Township-operated snowplow shall knock down or otherwise damage a homeowner's mailbox or post, the Township shall pay the owner of the mailbox the total amount of \$50.00.
- 2) If either the mailbox or post is knocked down or otherwise damaged by the force of the snow, the Township shall not make any restitution to the owner of the mailbox.
