ORDINANCE NO. 2 of 2013

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SILVER SPRING,
CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING FEES FOR
RETURN CHECK CHARGES, ESTABLISHING SERVICE CHARGE FEES FOR
TAX COLLECTOR WRITTEN CERTIFICATIONS AS TO THE PAYMENT STATUS
OF REAL ESTATE TAXES AND APPOINTING THE TAX COLLECTOR AS THE
MUNICIPAL OFFICIAL AUTHORIZED TO PROVIDE TAX CERTIFICATIONS
AND ESTABLISHING A FEE FOR PROVIDING TAX CERTIFICATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Silver Spring,
Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1:

A. The duly elected Tax Collector in and for Silver Spring Township or the duly appointed Tax Collector in the event of a vacancy in the office of Tax Collector (the "Tax Collector"), is hereby appointed the municipal official to provide real estate tax certifications upon request by the public on real property within Silver Spring Township.

B. The Tax Collector is authorized to assess, collect and retain as compensation for providing the service of issuing tax certifications, a fee of up to Twenty-Five and no/00 Dollars (\$25.00) per year for each tax certification requested.

C. The Tax Collector is authorized to assess, collect and retain as compensation for providing duplicate tax bills or research with respect to tax payments, a fee of up to Five and no/00 Dollars (\$5.00) per parcel for each tax year researched.

D. The Tax Collector is authorized to assess, collect and retain as compensation, a fee of Twenty-Five and no/00 Dollars (\$25.00) from any person(s), corporation, partnership, association or other entity which makes payment to the Tax Collector of any sum, whether for taxes, fees, charges, interest, penalties, obligations or other amounts owed, for which a check is dishonored and returned from the banking institution.

SECTION 2: Any ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: The provisions of this ordinance shall be severable, and if any provision hereunder shall be declared unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, then such declaration shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Township of Silver Spring that this Ordinance would have been enacted as if any such unconstitutional, herein, illegal, or invalid provision(s) had not been included.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after enactment.
