WHEREAS, the 2008 Right-to-Know law needs to be amended as stated in **Senate Bill 444**, which would make several needed changes, specifically to allow a commercial request fee to help recoup administrative labor costs; and,

WHEREAS, local ordinances and meetings must be advertised in newspapers of general circulation to notify the public; however, development in our society and technology have changed the way citizens get their news.

WHEREAS, the decreased printing schedules of traditional newspapers and their increasing advertising rates have left local officials with no choice but to seek new ways to notify the public; and

WHEREAS, clarify the law's application to records related to third-party contractors; and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the municipality of Silver Spring, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, heartily recommends your positive support for the various bills enumerated in this resolution.
