RESOLUTION 2010-7

A Resolution of Silver Spring Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, adopting a five-year smoothing method to determine the actuarial value of assets as part of the actuarial valuation for the Silver Spring Township Non-Uniformed Employees Pension Plan, according to §203.2 of the regulations covering the implementation of the actuarial funding rules of Act 205 of 1984 (P.L. 1005, No. 205, 53 P.S. §§895.101-895.803) published by the Public Employee Retirement Commission.

WHEREAS, Silver Spring Township has previously submitted the actuarial valuation reports for the Silver Spring Township Non-Uniformed Employees Pension Plan using the fair market value of plan assets to determine the actuarial value of assets; and

WHEREAS, Silver Spring Township desires to use a five-year smoothing method to determine the actuarial value of assets, up to a maximum of 120% of the market value of assets, effective with the January 1, 2009, actuarial valuation report; and

WHEREAS, Silver Spring Township desires to adopt a method of valuing assets for actuarial valuation purposes under §203.2 of the regulations cited above as determined by the Plan's actuary.


NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved and enacted by Silver Spring Township that the five-year smoothing method of determine the actuarial value of assets be adopted for the Plan, effective with the January 1, 2009, actuarial valuation report.

RESOLUTION FOR PLAN REVISION FOR NEW LAND DEVELOPMENT

RESOLUTION OF THE (SUPERVISORS) (COMMISSIONERS) (COUNCILMEN) of Silver Spring
(TOWNSHIP) (BOROUGH) (CITY), Cumberland COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA (hereinafter "the municipality").

WHEREAS Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act", as Amended, and the rules and Regulations of the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (Department) adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, require the municipality to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters of the Commonwealth and/or environmental health hazards from sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to determine whether a proposed method of sewage disposal for a new land development conforms to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management, and

WHEREAS Brian & Heather Brenneman has proposed the development of a parcel of land identified as

Brenneman Subdivision, and described in the attached Sewage Facilities Planning Module, and

proposes that such subdivision be served by: (check all that apply), sewer tap-ins, sewer extension, new treatment facility, individual onlot systems, community onlot systems, spray irrigation, retaining tanks, other, (please specify).

WHEREAS, Silver Spring Township finds that the subdivision described in the attached
